Gaelscoil Ráth Tó amalgamates with
Gaelscoil na Mí.

Gaelscoil Ráth Tó opened in Sept. 2010 after two years of hard work by a group of dedicated parents who realised the huge demand for a Gaelscoil in Ratoath. With 35 children enrolled and ready to start on the first of September 2010, and 140 on their register, the Dept. of Education & Skills informed the Establishing Committee that GSRT would not be receiving recognition due to insufficient demographic growth in the area. Despite this set back, GSRT decided to open its doors, made possible by the support of Gaelscoileanna Teo and Aitheantas— a nationwide campaign which saw gaelscoileanna and Irish organisations from all over the country supporting the campaign for recognition for the school. However GSRT made a recent decision to source a new gaelscoil for its neighbouring and rapidly growing town of Ashbourne in an effort to ensure more children could avail of education ‘as Gaeilge’ and so from Sept. 2011 GSRT will amalgamate with Gaelscoil na Mí. The new and recognised school will be located temporarily in the GAA Club in Ashbourne.

Tumoideachais /Immersion Education

I scoileanna tumoideachais is í an Ghaeilge an teanga cumarsáide tríd na scoile agus an teanga teagaisc i ngach ábhar seachas Béarla. Tá sé mar aidhm againn atmaisféar Gaelach a chruthú agus an Ghaeilge mar theanga caidrimh idir baill foirne agus na daltaí agus idir na daltaí iad féin chomh luath agus is féidir. Cuirfear fáilte roimh iarracht ar bith ó thuismitheoirí na scoile.

Immersion education means that pupils learn all subjects through the medium of a designated language (Gaeilge). It is our aim to create an Irish language atmosphere in the school, in which Irish is the language of communication and the language of instruction. Irish is spoken at all times between staff and children and among children as soon as they are able to. Any attempt made by parents to communicate ‘as Gaeilge’ will be welcomed and respected.



Curriculum Subjects & Extra-Curricular Activities

Beidh an scoil ag feidhmiú faoi rialacha na Roinne Oideachais & Scileanna do scoileanna náisiúnta. Leanfaidh an scoil Curaclam na Bunscoile (1999): Gaeilge T1, Béarla T2, Matamaitic, Oideachas Ealaíon (Ceol, Drámaíocht & na hAmharcealaíona), O.S.I.E. (Oideachas Soisialta, Imshaoil & Eolaíochta -Stair, Tíreolas & Eolaíocht), O.S.P.S. (Oid. Soisialta, Pear-santa & Sláinte) & Corp Oideachas.

The school will operate under the regulations of the Dept. of Ed & Skills for national schools. The school will follow the Primary School Curriculum (1999): Irish L1, English L2, Mathematics, Arts Education (Music, Drama, Visual Arts), S.E.S.E. (Social, Environmental, Scientific Education—History, Geography, Science), S.P.H.E. (Social Personal & Health Education) and Physical Education.
